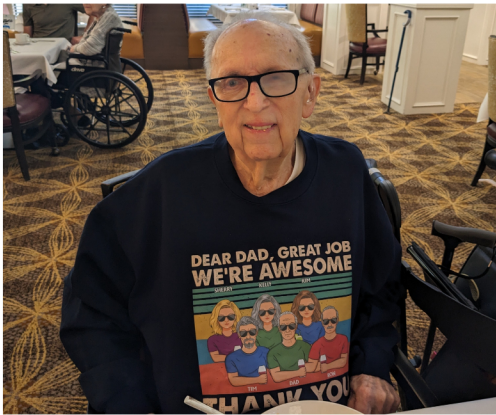
The other fruits available included the following: oranges, blood oranges, mandarins, pears, pink lady apples, peaches, large

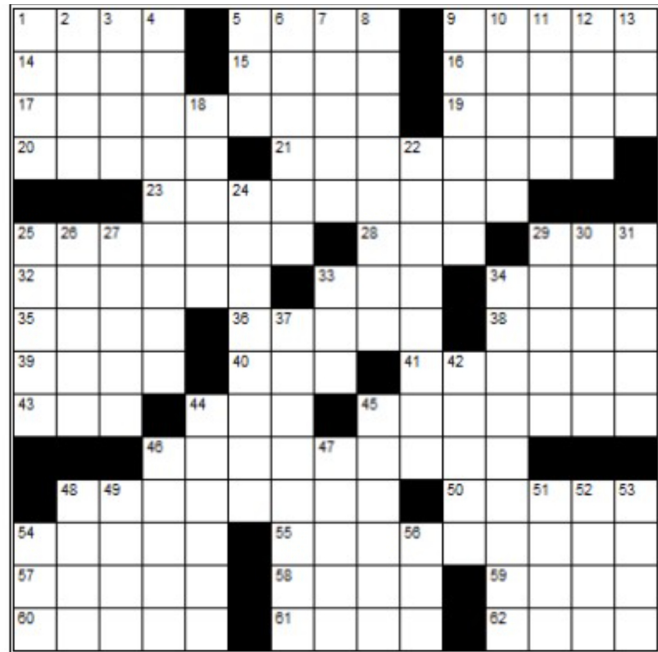
